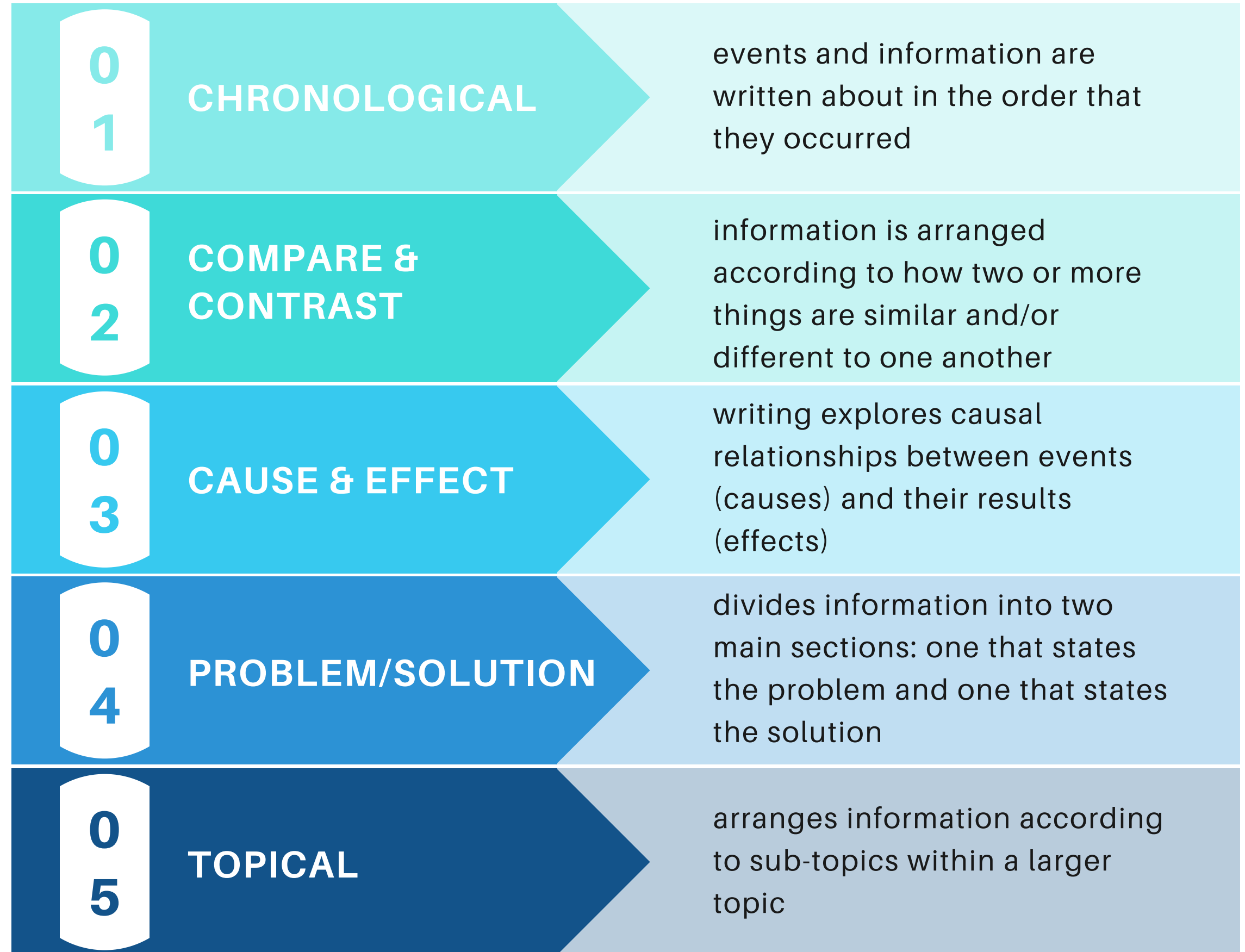


# Organizational Patterns

# Chronological

events and information are written about in the order that they occurred



# Compare & Contrast

information is arranged according to how two or more things are similar and/or different to one another



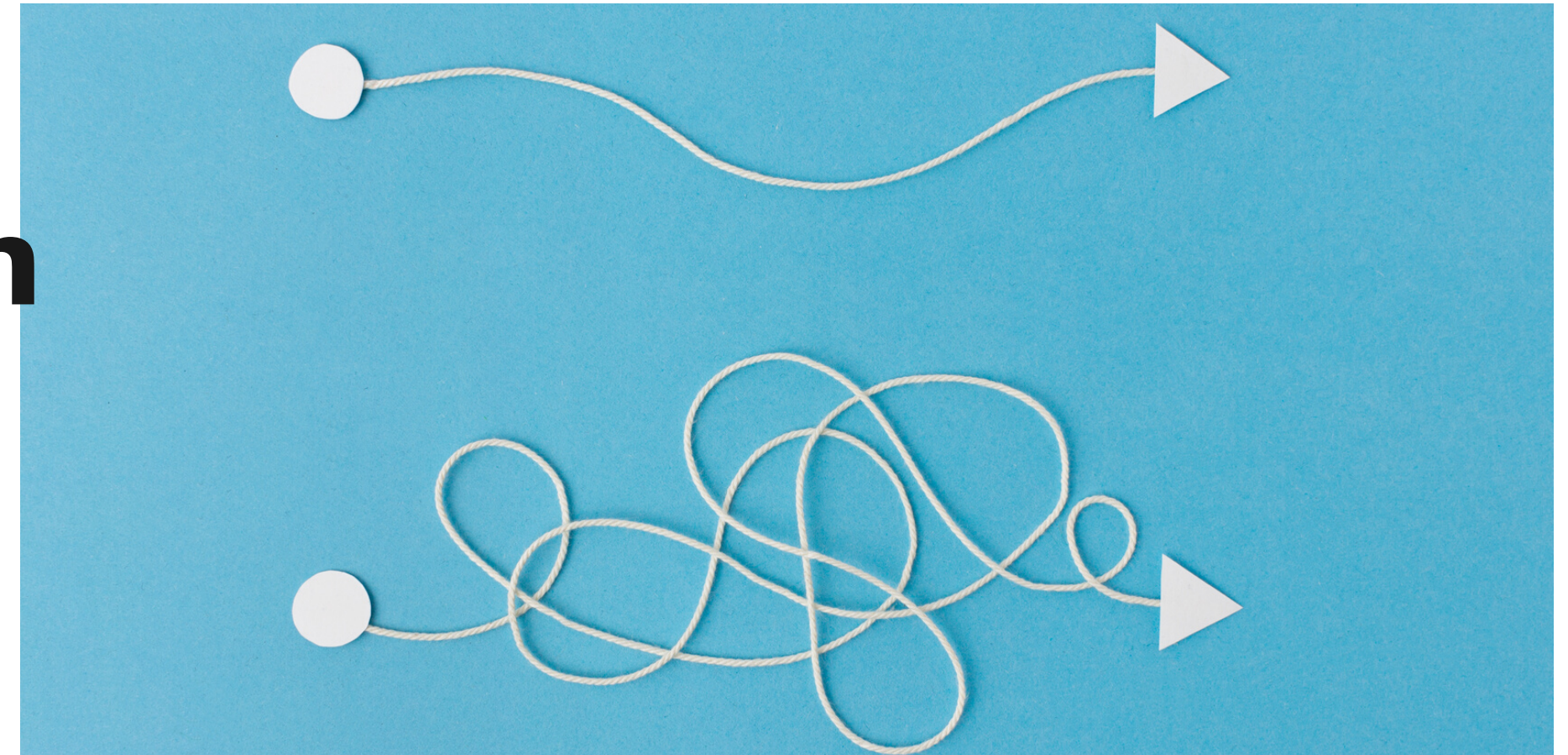
# Cause and Effect

writing explores causal relationships between events (causes) and their results (effects)



# Problem/Solution

divides information into two main sections: one that states the problem and one that states the solution



# Topical

arranges information according to sub-topics within a larger topic
